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SUBJECT: Reporting Positive Drug Findings during EFFECTIVE DATE: March 2002

## **PURPOSE**

To provide guidelines for reporting positive drug findings on inmates.

## **POLICY**

Positive drug screens during diagnostic work-up are to be considered confidential patient's information as is all medical inmate information.

## **PROCEDURE**

Rarely would a physician need to order a drug screen. At times which this might occur, i.e. Emergency Room visit, information should be given to medical personnel only.

As Custody does randomly complete drug tests on inmate, the medical staff could advise Custody they might want to do a drug screen on a particular inmate without divulging any information as to drug screen that has been completed by medical staff. Custody could then develop their own findings and conclusions.
