## **PURPOSE**

To provide guidelines on placement of aged and infirmed inmates.

## **POLICY**

The Division of Prisons recognizes that some inmates will require special housing accommodations because of disability, aging, and untreatable medical conditions. Inmates with these conditions will be housed at facilities that can supply these accommodations and meet the security needs of the inmates.

## **PROCEDURE**

Health Services will identify, staff, and equip specified facilities for the care of the aged and infirmed inmate based on their acuity level.
