Report on the Need to Use Funds to Provide the State

Match for Federal Grants

DATE:

Section 19.1 of Session Law 2010-31 (Senate Bill 897) requires the Department of Correction to report to the Chairs of the House of Representatives and Senate Appropriations Subcommittees on Justice and Public Safety and the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations prior to using funds to provide the state match needed to receive federal grant funds. Pursuant to Section 19.1, the Department reports the need to expend \$130,234 to provide the state match for the following grant award that begins September 1, 2010:

**Division:** Alcoholism and Chemical Dependency Programs **Grant Title:** 2010 Residential Substance Abuse Treatment (RSAT). This award from the North Carolina Governor's Crime Commission will fund a new long term (6 to 12 months) treatment program for 55 adult male offenders in minimum custody. The program will be located at the Dan River Prison Work Farm in Yanceyville, North Carolina and will be available to qualifying male inmates statewide. Seven (7) receipt supported time-limited positions will be funded with this award. This is a two year grant with a scheduled start date of September 1, 2010. The total award is \$520,938 for year one (SFY2010-11) and \$478,438 for year two (SFY 2011-2012). The state match for year one is \$130,234 and will be expended

during this reporting period. The state match for year two is \$119,610 and a request to expend those funds will be included in the 2011 legislative report.
