

Current Revision Summary (if applicable):

.1908 (b) (2) (A) now reads: When supervising inmates in a standing position, officers shall maintain weapons in a safe position and always maintain a minimum of twenty (20) yards distance from all inmates. This distance is critical to give an armed officer time to react effectively in the event that an inmate rapidly approaches and tries to overpower the officer. Weapon carry positions that facilitate readiness and safety include:

Previous reference to “supervising inmates in a seated position” has been removed from this policy.
